Minimally Invasive Techniques for Difficult Porcelain Laminate Veneers (PLV) Cases

The key to very precise and predictable tooth preparation is a proven and reliable step-by-step procedure. This includes wax-up, silicon indexes and related techniques such as APR (Aesthetic Pre-recontouring), APT (Aesthetic Pre-evaluative Temporaries) and preparation through the Aesthetic Pre-evaluative Temporaries. These extremely crucial steps eliminate all possible mistakes and destruction of tooth substance. They prevent cutting too deep with depth cutters without adjusting for the aging affects on enamel (volumetric enamel loss) or inappropriate teeth positions in the dental arch.

Dr. Gürel is the founder and the honorary president of EDAD (Turkish Academy of Aesthetic Dentistry). He is the President Elect of the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry (EAED) for 2011 & 2012, as well as a member of the American Society for Dental Aesthetics (ASDA) and the honorary diplomate of the American Board of Aesthetic Dentistry (ABAD).

Dr. Gürel is also the editor-in-chief of the Quintessence Magazin in Turkey and on the editorial board of the AACD journal, PPAD (Practical Procedure & Aesthetic Dentistry), EJED (European Journal of Esthetic Dentistry).

He has been lecturing on dental aesthetics all over the world and giving post graduate lectures on aesthetics at the New York University, New York and Yeditepe University in Turkey. He is the author of »The Science and Art of Porcelain Laminate Veneers« published by Quintessence publications in 2003 translated into 10 different languages.

Dr. Gürel has been practicing in his own clinic in Istanbul, specializing in Aesthetic Dentistry, since 1984.

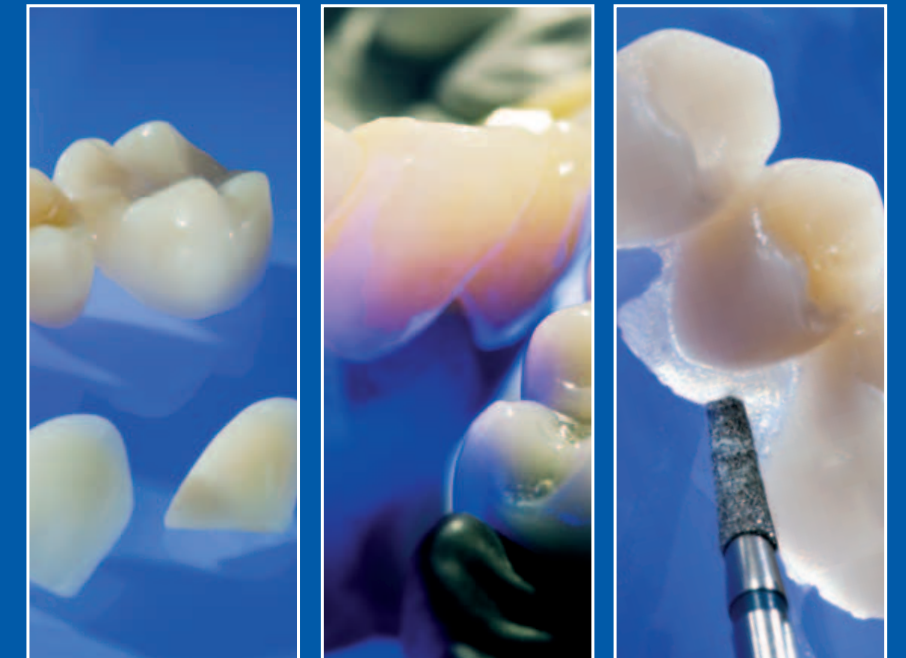
