He was awarded the Singapore Excellence Service Award, Silver in 2004 (youngest dental officer). He served in different government institutions including National Dental Centre, Health Promotion Board, School Dental services, and Polyclinics. Dr Goh was appointed head of Queenstown and Geylang polyclinics during his tenure. He joined private practice after finishing his bond with the government and was the Physician leader for Raffles Dental group Tampines branch (2012-2014) and was a Raffles Dental International advisor (2014-2018)

He completed his Certificate of Oral implantology from the University of Frankfurt in 2010 and subsequently completed his Master of Oral Implantology from the University of Frankfurt in 2016

Dr Goh is a multidisciplinary dental surgeon with special interest in implantology and aesthetic dentistry .
