Course Synopsis

Perfecting your posterior composites - Dr. Anthony Tay

Course Synopsis

Since the introduction of composite, its use for posterior region has come a long way, in terms of material science and simplification of techniques. Today, posterior composite can be used routinely in a conservative and natural manner. The challenges for many general practitioners, remain however, in balancing the efficiency of the time spent, with a necessary predictability of the final restoration. In this workshop, Dr Anthony Tay will detail and demonstrate the efficient and reliable technique for class 2 composite restoration, including the use of the modern bulkfill composite. Clinical tips will be shared to achieve excellence and esthetics, while avoiding common mistakes, in posterior composite placement. With the hands-on training provided, practitioners will gain the confidence to place predictable posterior composite their daily practice efficiently.

- 2. Knowing how to efficiently rubber-dam your patients

Aesthetic anterior direct restorations - Dr. Ronnie Yap

Course Synopsis

Direct resin reconstruction of the severely compromised anterior dentition is one of the more difficult challenges of clinical dentistry. The anterior dentition can present in many different shades, opacity and translucency. During this ADSS workshop participants will have the opportunity to restore a fractured central incisor using an aesthetic dental model that mimics the anatomy of natural teeth and the opportunity to learn more about anterior teeth esthetics.

They will be shown the MiCD Global Network Direct Resin Protocol using the Shofu range of bioactive composites and have the opportunity to contour and finish the restoration to a life-like natural lustre. At the end of the session they should have a greater appreciation on how to blend the different resins to achieve predictable aesthetic outcomes and understand a simplified method of finishing and polishing a direct anterior restoration.

- 2. Understand the macro and micro anatomy of anterior teeth
- 3. Learn to recontour and achieve a lustre like polish that mimics natural enamel

Course Synopsis

Occlusion remains one of the most confusing topics in dentistry today due to seemingly different opinions of choosing a particular philosophy of managing each and every patient. This issue is made worse, as seen from the restorative failures occurring to clinicians frequently despite meeting the occlusal "philosophies" that are known. This course will touch on some basic theory of dental occlusion and the practical application of these theories in everyday clinical practice. Clinical cases will be shared to illustrate and further explain the rationale of choosing some of these theories in our everyday clinical practice.

The hands-on section will consist of discussion of occlusion, and hands on exercises of using a semi-adjustable articulator and making accurate facebow and maxillo-mandibular relationship records to facilitate occlusal analysis and working-up a complex restorative case.
