

Non-Surgical Facial Aesthetics: A Combined Approach using Energy Based Devices and Injectable Treatments

We will be exploring a multi-modality approach to facial aesthetics using the full spectrum of non-surgical techniques. This sharing will include:

- Non-invasive treatments like topical cosmeceuticals
- Energy based devices like pigment lasers and resurfacing fractional lasers
- Skin tightening treatments like microneedling radiofrequency and high intensity focussed ultrasound
- Injectable treatments like botulinum toxin, skin boosters & dermal fillers

How Orthodontics Can Aid In Restorative Dentistry Treatment

Certain restorative procedures cannot be effectively performed unless the teeth are properly aligned. For example, an over-erupted upper molar opposing an edentulous lower arch can render lower implant restoration impossible due to insufficient interocclusal space. Similarly, if adjacent teeth are tilted, there will not be sufficient interdental space for successful implant restorations.

Additionally, a bridge is unlikely to be durable if the neighbouring teeth are misaligned. Anterior aesthetic restorations will also be compromised if the teeth are not positioned correctly.

By repositioning teeth into optimal alignment, clinicians gain greater flexibility in restoring the dentition

Implant Aesthetics – The Immediate Anterior Implant

The single anterior implant is one of the most aesthetically demanding procedures in dentistry.

Knowledge of ideal tooth proportions & position, ideal gingival heights & zeniths, mastery of implant placement parameters, as well as soft tissue management skills are necessary to successfully navigate this region of dentistry.

However, timing of implant placement can also make or break the outcomes of an anterior implant. This lecture thus aims to explore the realm of immediate anterior implant placement, & how timing implant placement can also be our biggest asset in this area.
